## Waste Management at Praia do Matadeiro

Matadeiro Beach is the city's first Zero Waste Beach. Characterized by its geographic isolation and direct contact with nature, it is the perfect place for environmentally sound waste management. Check the guidelines below to correctly participate in the services and contribute to the city's goals.

- Organic Waste: separate fruit and vegetable peels, eggshells, and coffee grounds in the 3L small bucket located on your kitchen sink. Treatment must be done locally using home composting kits.
- **Glass:** separate bottles, jars, and cups and dispose of them at the Glass Drop-off Point (PEV) in front of the Armação Church.
- **Dry Recyclables:** separate metals, plastics, paper, and cardboard, pack them in colored or transparent/clear bags and dispose them on Mondays and Fridays starting at 1 PM at the Waste Management Center, in the Dry Recyclables compartment (Blue).
- **General Waste:** Unsorted/mixed waste must be placed in black bags and disposed of at the Waste Management Center, in the General Waste compartment (Gray).

## **ATTENTION!**

Bulky waste, such as furniture, appliances, construction debris, tires, and wood, as well as light bulbs, batteries, and cooking oil cannot be disposed of at the Waste Recovery Center.

These wastes can be taken to the Morro das Pedras Ecopoint, on Rua Francisco Vieira. For bulky items, collection can also be scheduled via **WhatsApp at (48) 3216-0202.**
